

# Georgia GOP Convention Guide



The Georgia Republican Party is a grassroots organization. In a four year time period, there are three convention cycles.

- Odd Years (2021 & 2023) - Conventions are held to elect leadership for precinct, county, district, & state organizations.
- Presidential Election Years (2024) - Conventions are held from the precinct to the national level in a process to elect delegates to the National Convention. We also elect our National Committeeman and Committeewoman to represent us at all RNC meetings.
- Midterm Election Years (2022) - There are no Conventions.

The State Committee establishes the dates for the Precinct, County, District, and State Conventions. The following is intended to be a summary of the events. the Call for these meetings is sent to each County and District Chairmen. These Chairmen then select the location for their meetings.

## STEP 1

### Precinct Caucus (Mass Meetings)

**Saturday, March 20, 2021 - 10:00AM**  
**Counties with pop. OVER 80K only**

- Elect Precinct Meeting Chair & Secretary
- Elect Precinct Officers to serve for 2 years
- Elect Delegates & Alternates to the County Conventions



## STEP 2

### County Convention (Counties under 80K will hold Mass Meetings at 9:00AM)

**Saturday, April 17, 2021 - 10:00AM**

- Elect County Chair & other officers
- Elect County Committee members
- Elect Delegates & Alternates to the District Convention
- Elect Delegates & Alternates to the State Convention
- Convention



## STEP 3

### District Convention

**Saturday, May 15, 2021 - 10:00AM**

- Elect District Chair & other officers
- Elect District members to serve on the State Committee



## STEP 4

### State Convention

**Friday & Saturday, June 4-5, 2021**

- Elect State Chair & other officers
- Any other necessary & proper business
